We offer on-campus accommodation at the Murdoch University Village.

Ineligible Programmes

Students receiving US Federal Aid are governed by stringent US Department of Education regulations. Only campus based students studying on a full time or at least half time basis are eligible to apply.

The following programmes are not eligible:

- Nursing
- Non-degree programmes (e.g. Graduate Diplomas and Graduate Certificate programs)
- Courses with any period of study abroad
- Programmes studied less than 'half-time' (part-time)
- Any programmes delivered by distance learning

Students on ineligible courses can apply for a private loan to fund the full cost of their course via a private loan provider, such as <u>Sallie Mae.</u>

Courses that are taught or part taught with another institution that is not eligible or not certified to participate in the William D Ford Direct Loans (Direct Loan) programme.
